Dear Secretary Bose and Deputy Secretary Davis:

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued the “Order on Offer of Settlement and Issuing New License”<sup>2</sup> (License) and “Order on Rehearing”<sup>3</sup> for the Lake Chelan Hydroelectric Project (Project) on November 6, 2006, and April 19, 2007, respectively. License Articles 401, License Article 410, and Agreement Article 10(j) of Appendix A requested the Public Utility District No. 1 of Chelan County, Washington (Chelan PUD or Licensee), to file for Commission approval a Cultural Resources Interpretive and Education Program within three years of the date of issuance of the License.

Chelan PUD, in consultation with the Lake Chelan Cultural Forum (LCCF), hereby files the Program with the Commission. The LCCF expressed that the Program address the intent and themes of the educational and interpretive elements.

The Program was developed in consultation with the Lake Chelan Cultural Forum (LCCF) as recorded in the minutes of April 14, May 12 and September 9, 2009. The forum members discussed the provisions, offered direction and provided comments on the interpretive booklet and the curriculum development. Copies of the minutes of the consultation are included as a separate filing.
