Dear Ms. Smith:

This letter is in reference to your December 13, 2010 filing of your 2010 report on historic properties and cultural resources activities for the Lake Chelan Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 637) and the Rocky Reach Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2145). Your report was filed in accordance with the Lake Chelan and Rocky Reach Historic Properties and Cultural Resources Management Plans and the Programmatic Agreement for the projects. In accordance with license articles 410 and 405, respectively, you are required to file a report within 30 days of every anniversary of the date of issuance of the licenses.<sup>1</sup>

Your report was completed in consultation with the Lake Chelan and Rocky Reach Cultural Forums. In 2010, members of the Lake Chelan and Rocky Reach Cultural Forums agreed to combine the two forums into one creating the Lake Chelan/Rocky Reach Cultural Forum. Your report combines into one document the annual reporting requirements for cultural activities for the Lake Chelan and Rocky Reach Projects. The annual report contains culturally sensitive information that should not be released to the public.

Additional copies of your report were filed with the Washington State Historic Preservation Office, the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation Tribal Historic
