
This acknowledges receipt of your 2010 Annual Implementation and Monitoring Report, filed January 21, 2011, pursuant to Article 408(g) of the November 6, 2006 Order Issuing New License for the Lake Chelan Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 637).

License Article 408(g) requires you to file your report with the Commission by January 31 of each year to document measures completed in the previous year in accordance with Article 14 of the Lake Chelan Settlement Agreement. You state that neither National Marine Fisheries Service nor Washington Department of Ecology proposed any measures or lease/purchases of water rights for action in 2010. However, you state that discussions were initiated in late 2010 regarding a potential project in the Okanogan River basin for implementation in 2011. As a result of no specific projects being funded during 2010, no monitoring occurred and annual funding under Article 14 will again be carried-over to 2011 as required.

Please be advised that, while Commission staff will continue to review these filings, staff will no longer issue acknowledgement letters for future filings under this license requirement, unless further Commission action is necessary. When your future filings for this requirement are posted on the Commission's e-library system, you may consider that as acknowledgement of the Commission's acceptance of your submittal.
