Re: Rocky Reach Hydroelectric Project No. 2145 Request for Approval of Entiat Park Contract Plans and Specifications

Dear Ms. Bose and Mr. Davis:

On October 12, 2010, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued the "Order Modifying and Approving Revised Recreation Management Plan" for the Rocky Reach Hydroelectric Project (Project). Ordering Paragraph (C) requested that the Public Utility District No. 1 of Chelan County, Washington (Chelan PUD) shall file final construction drawings for the improvements at Entiat Park, including erosion and sedimentation control measures, trash clean-up and removal provisions, a discussion of how the needs of the disabled were considered in the planning and design of the improvements.

In accordance with the above Order, Chelan PUD hereby files electronically, with this letter, an electronic file for each of the items listed below. Additionally, in accordance with license article 302, hard copies will be filed with the Commission's Director of Division of Dam Safety and Inspections and the Portland Regional Office by copy of this letter.

- Quality Control Inspection Plan (QCIP)
- Volume I: Sections A-G Contract documents including Technical Specifications
- Volume II: Section H Construction Drawings
- Volume III: Section I Additional Information and Permits

Erosion and sediment control measures are illustrated in Volume II: Section H - Construction Drawings and further described in Volume I: Section G - Technical Specifications (see Section G Sub-section 02270). The Temporary Sediment and Erosion Control Plan (TESCP) is also included in the Technical Specifications.

Trash clean up during construction is the responsibility of the Contractor as described in Volume I: Section C – General Conditions, Part 10.8. Clean-up. Following construction work

provisions have been made to locate garbage receptacles throughout the park and the City of Entiat will be responsible to pick up and collect trash on a regular basis.

The needs of the disabled were taken into consideration on every aspect of the park design from width and grade of trails to designated disabled campsites, universal picnic tables, fire rings, comfort stations built to American Disabilities Act standards, playgrounds, designated disabled parking, and the pay-station, as is evidenced on the construction drawings. In addition, there will be appropriate signage identifying the designated disabled parking stalls. These features are illustrated in Volume II: Section H – Construction Drawings.

As part of the planning process, Chelan PUD consulted with, and received the necessary permits from the City of Entiat for Shoreline Substantial Development Permits, Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife for Hydraulic Project Approval and Washington State Department of Natural Resources for Permit to Remove or Destroy a Survey monument (See Volume III: Section I – Additional Information and Permits). Chelan PUD has been working with the United States Army Corps of Engineers and has not yet received a permit from them. When the Corpos permit is received, we will file it with the Commission.

The following permits are also in progress, building permit from the City of Entiat for the Comfort Stations, Department of Ecology Construction Stormwater General Permit, Department of Ecology - Water Quality Certification. Construction will not begin until all permits are received.

In an effort to safeguard the general public Chelan PUD in coordination with the City of Entiat is planning to close the park to the public during the construction period anticipated to be from October 1, 2012 through May 23, 2014.

Chelan PUD would appreciate any comments you may have as soon as practicable, as it would be helpful in our efforts to maintain the overall project schedule.
