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A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF LYDIG CONSTRUCTION, INC OF SPOKANE VALLEY, WA TO PROVIDE GENERAL CONTRACTOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGER (GCCM) SERVICES FOR THE ROCK ISLAND AND ROCKY REACH HYDROELECTRIC SUPPORT FACILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND TO AUTHORIZE THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR SAID SERVICES

FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND REASONS FOR ACTION

On April 2, 2018, by Resolution No. 18-14232, the Commission of the District authorized the General Manager to invite sealed proposals to provide General Contractor Construction Manager (GCCM) services to the District in support of planned improvements to Rock Island Dam and Rocky Reach Dam operation and maintenance facilities. Work at both sites includes installation of site utilities and demolition, construction and/or refurbishment of buildings for fabrication, machine work, sandblast, paint, warehouse, office, crew facilities, storage, fueling, hazardous material handling and various other activities.

Resolution No. 17-14215 requires that the Commission, by resolution, award Request for Proposals (RFP) that exceed \$3,000,000.

On April 4, 2018 the District solicited Request for Proposals from GCCM firms. On April 20, 2018 the District received four (4) Proposals. The evaluation team reviewed and scored the proposals provided by the firms and advanced three (3) firms to the interview stage based on qualifications and project understanding, as provided in RCW 39.10. On May 17 and 18, 2018 the evaluation team interviewed the qualified firms. After scoring the interviews, two (2) firms were invited to submit Request for Final Proposals (RFFP). On July 10, 2018, the District received and publically opened two (2) Final Proposals. The evaluation team reviewed and selected Lydig Construction, Inc. based on the combined scores for proposal, interview and pricing.

District's staff has determined that Lydig Construction, Inc. is the firm best qualified to provide the anticipated work and that the proposal provided for said work is fair, reasonable and meets all statutory requirements.

District's staff recommends awarding RFP No. 18-33 to Lydig Construction, Inc. Lydig will assist the District with Pre-Construction Services. When design is complete, Lydig and the District will negotiate a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) to build the Rock Island Improvements and, subsequently, the Rocky Reach Improvements. Throughout the duration of the projects, the awarded contract shall be

amended, by Board resolution, to include construction work to be completed for the guaranteed maximum price.. The General Manager of the District concurs with District staff's recommendation.

ACTION

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF CHELAN COUNTY, as follows:

Section 1. Lydig Construction, Inc. of Spokane Valley, WA has been identified as the most qualified proposer for General Contractor Construction Manager Services for the Rock Island and Rocky Reach Hydroelectric Support Facility Improvements project based on their qualifications and final proposal. The General Manager of the District is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Lydig Construction, Inc. The contract amount shall not exceed \$220,000 without prior Board approval. A copy of the contract will be on file in the offices of the District.

A RESOLUTION REJECTING THE BID OF VOITH HYDRO, INC. AND ACCEPTING THE BID OF K & N ELECTRIC, INC. OF SPOKANE VALLEY, WA (BID 17-76) FOR ROCKY REACH UNIT C9 WICKET GATE MODIFICATIONS

FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND REASONS FOR ACTION

On July 6, 2018, an invitation for sealed bids was published in accordance with RCW 54.04.070 and Resolution No 17-14215 to provide/construct Rocky Reach Unit C9 Wicket Gate Modifications. Bid proposals were opened on July 31, 2018, at 2:00, p.m. in the offices of the District. Two bids were received (excluding sales tax) as tabulated on Exhibit A attached.

The bid by Voith Hydro, Inc. did not meet the minimum requirements specified in the contract documents. They submitted exceptions and clarifications/limitations to the District's commercial terms. This bid should be rejected as non-responsive.

District staff has determined that the bid of K & N Electric, Inc. of Spokane Valley, WA in the amount of \$982,851.00 (excluding sales tax) is the lowest responsive and best bid in compliance with the plans and specifications for Bid No. 17-76. This bid meets all statutory requirements. Resolution No. 17-14215 requires that the rejection of the apparent low dollar bidder must come before the Commission for action.

District staff recommends awarding Bid No. 17-76 to K & N Electric, Inc.

The General Manager of the District concurs with District staff's recommendation.

ACTION

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF CHELAN COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. The bid submitted by Voith Hydro, Inc. of York, PA did not meet the minimum requirements specified in the contract documents and is hereby rejected.

Section 2. The bid submitted by K & N Electric, Inc. of Spokane Valley, WA is the lowest responsible and best bid in compliance with the plans and specifications to provide/construct Rocky Reach Unit C9 Wicket Gate Modifications. The General Manager of the District is hereby authorized to enter

into a contract with K & N Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$982,851.00, excluding sales tax. A copy of the contract will be on file in the offices of the District
