

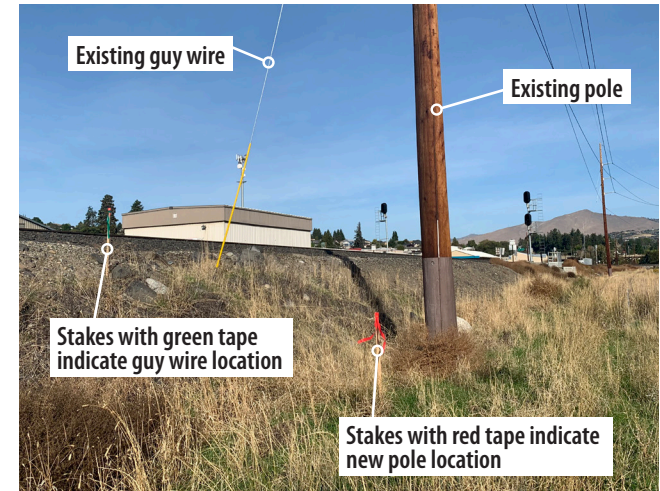
# CHELAN TRANSMISSION FIRE HARDENING PROJECT

The PUD has proposed upgrading a transmission line between Chelan Falls and Union Valley from wood to steel poles. Steel poles allow fires to pass by them without burning, meaning lines can either remain in service during a fire, or experience much shorter temporary outages.

## Check the Stakes on Your Property

- Stakes have been placed in the ground indicating the approximate location of the replacement transmission poles, and any guy wires.
- Stakes with red tape indicate the location of replacement poles.
- Stakes with green tape indicate the location of guy wires.

- Newly installed transmission poles will be similar to the existing poles, but made of steel instead of wood.
- Poles may be taller, and wire may be thicker, than existing material.
- The PUD will install new poles close to the location of the existing poles, move electrical wires to the new poles, and then remove the old poles.
- **You are receiving this postcard because you have one or more stake(s) on your property — please check the location of these stakes, and let us know if you have any questions or concerns about the proposed pole location.**
