Campsite registration

Welcome campers

Please follow these 4 steps:

- **Camper must immediately establish a campsite by selecting a site that is not occupied.** (Paying for a site before it is vacated is NOT ALLOWED. Placing property in a site before it is vacated is NOT ALLOWED.)
- **Establish campsite by placing substantial personal property in an open site, i.e. licensed vehicle, trailer, tent, dining fly, etc.** (Lawn chairs, coolers, tablecloths are NOT substantial personal property.)
- **Pay for your site* within 30 minutes of setup and before 1 p.m. the following day.** (Checkout time is 1 p.m. Remaining in a campsite beyond checkout time requires a late fee equal to an additional day's camping fee.)
- **Post your camping permit.** (A courtesy to other campers and staff to clearly identify the site is registered and occupied). Please contact park staff for assistance with this if needed.

Attention:

Failure to comply with the Park rules and regulations can result in the loss of campsite(s), eviction and forfeiture of camping fees.

- A maximum of 8 people and/or 3 vehicles permitted at a campsite.
- Tents in designated tent areas only.
