No, they emit much less radio frequency (RF) than your microwave or cell phone and only in short milliseconds at any one time for a total of less than two minutes per day. Another thing to remember is that they are located on the outside of your house. RF dissipates quite quickly in less than a few feet, too.

Please join us at an open house and we can talk more and show you the RF.

These meters also have to meet all federal standards.
