Rules & Regulations

- Site saving is not allowed
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages prohibited
- Campers must register all vehicles immediately after setting up camp
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.
- Camping is allowed in designated areas only
- Campers must vacate campsites by 1 p.m. or pay an additional day's fee
- Speed limit 5 mph unless otherwise posted
- Vehicles must park in designated parking areas only
- Pets must be on leash and attended at all times
- Discharge of firearms or fireworks is prohibited
- Swimming is allowed in designated areas only
- Glass containers and pets are not allowed on the beach
- A complete list of rules and regulations are available at park registration kiosk

- A maximum of 8 people and/or 3 vehicles permitted at a campsite.
