

# Let's talk about rates

Chelan County PUD commissioners are considering changes in rates for electric, water and sewer service. They've heard the results of a study of what it costs to serve different types of customers and reviewed options for rate design to accomplish goals including:

- Electric rates that promote conservation.
- Better align rates among different types of customers.
- Small rate increases over time.

Commissioners are seeking your comments on options that would raise electric rate revenue by an estimated 2.5 percent, water rate revenue by 6.9 percent and sewer rate revenue by 6.5 percent.
