Subject: Bypass Reach Fish Stranding Survey

Keely Murdoch, Scott Kreiter, and Jeff Osborn walked the gorge area, from the lower end of the boulder section up to the large deep pool/impassable fall. Pools were still connected by a small amount of flow supplied from bank storage. We observed approximately 15 rainbow trout, ranging in length from 8 to 14 inches, one small bass, and two or three suckers. A majority of the rainbows observed were located in the three or four pools downstream from the large deep pool/impassable fall. We did not observe any alive or dead anadromous fish. The only dead fish observed was the rear half of a sucker.

Scott provided GPS measurements for major features: dam, falls, pools, old bridge, bottom end of boulder section, potential fish barriers, etc. Digital photographs were taken at each GPS station for further identification of bypass reach features.
