Thank you for taking the time to meet with me on October 1, 2003 to discuss Rocky Reach relicensing. The purpose of this memo is to document our meeting and to recap the issues that were discussed.

During our meeting at your office on October 1, 2003, the following issues were discussed:

- The current status of Rocky Reach relicensing and the schedule.
  - License expires June, 2006
  - Final license application due June, 2004
- The “Steps for Section 106 Compliance” table.
  - Copy provided at meeting.
- FERC letter initiating consultation.
- Establishment of a working group and participating members.
  - Yakama Nation participated in initial stages, but no longer has the resources.
  - Chelan PUD will provide periodic updates. Phone conferencing will continue to be available.
- Status of Traditional Cultural Properties studies
  - TCP study has been finalized on behalf of the Yakama Nation.
  - A study is currently underway for the Colville Tribes.
- Cultural resources survey of the Rocky Reach project area
  - A final draft was provided during the meeting
- Status of the Historic Properties Management Plan
  - A second draft was provided during meeting
- Ceded lands and boundaries
- Protocols for consultation with the Yakama Nation

We appreciate your input regarding the relicensing of Rocky Reach Hydroelectric Project. We will continue to keep you updated throughout the process, and invite you to participate to the extent that you see fit.
