

## **Rocky Reach Recreation Needs Analysis - changes from first draft report to second draft report:**

- Added an executive summary in the front of the Rocky Reach Report that summarizes each section of the report (page 1)
- Referenced Exhibit R history discussion in Inventory Report (Section 1, p1-1))
- Added discussions about how tying growth in recreation to population does not necessarily provide an accurate indication of future recreation growth - other factors such as strength in the economy, changes in technology, etc. influence recreation activity (Section 6.2, p6-3)
- Revised discussions on IAC planning documents, BLM Land Management Plan, Entiat Park Plan, and added discussion on Washington State Parks Rocky Reach Trail Plan (Section 6.3, p6-10,6-8, 6-16, 6-13)).
- Separated out Daroga Group camping in tables and discussion (Section 7.1, p7-3, 7-28).
- Added short discussion regarding time of surveys and how local evening users would not been represented (Section 7.3 – p7-2)
- Mentioned in watercraft section that residential growth is changing - with many new homes and docks (Section 7)

Add further discussion of boat - trailer parking comparisons at parks, especially Entiat and Beebe Bridge - how many boaters park at campsites, so designated boat trailer parking areas are not really generally full - downplay needs for further parking in these areas. Also, similar situation for day-use parking and how additional parking would take recreation use areas. (Sections 7 and 8)

- Added info. regarding recent and planned improvements to Orondo Park - based on my discussion with Charlotte at the Park (Section 7, within different categories - i.e. boating, day-use, ADA accessibility).
- Added discussion regarding maintenance issues (per Gregg Jones comments) in Section 8 (p8-2).
- Added additional info. on playgrounds - swings (Section 7 and 8)
- Included info. on field sports, based on info. from Gregg Jones and City of Entiat. (Section 7 and 8)

**Rocky Reach Recreation Resources Inventory - changes from second draft report to final report:**

- Under Section 1.1 Background, last paragraph, added reference to the Recreation Needs report, since it's referred to throughout the Inventory report.
- Table 4-1 - added the new concrete boat ramp at Entiat Park completed in 1998.
- At the beginning of Section 7, added a paragraph explaining how the working group decided during development of the study plan what "near project area" sites were summarized.
- At the beginning of Section 8, added a paragraph describing what this section includes and discussed facility adequacy and condition information in the Appendix A Addendum document and the Recreation Needs Analysis Report.
- Beginning of Section 9, added a paragraph stating that this section summarizes existing plans that directly affect the recreation inventory and referenced the Needs Analysis for a complete summary of planning documents. Deleted all plans in this section that did not include plans for facilities that would affect the Inventory.
- Section 12.2 - added a discussion about the Mule deer population study that is currently underway.

**Rocky Reach Project Lands Management - changes from first draft report to second draft report:**

- Section 1.7 – added information from Socioeconomic study related to population changes.
- Section 1.8 - added more information to better describe land use concepts.
- Section 1.9 – added Entiat Valley Community Action Plan
- Section 1.9 – added more information related to Chelan PUD’s role in permitting and tracking land uses.
- Section 1.10, 1.11 – sections added to describe project boundary and lands, project structures and transmission lines
- Section 1.13 – section added to describe wildlife recreation areas
- Section 4 – total section revised. Includes Chelan PUD’s process for monitoring shoreline development.
- Section 6 – Example wording only. Working group will discuss and come to their own conclusion for final report.
- Appendix B and C – copy of JARPA and PUD Inventory Forms added.
