**Social Resources Working Group  
Considerations for evaluating  
protection, mitigation and enhancement measures**

**Preliminary Assessment**

1. Relationship to Project impacts:
  - Is it protection or mitigation measure directly associated with Project facilities or operation; or
  - Is the measure an enhancement?
  - Is the issue an ongoing impact associated with Project operation?
  - Is the measure an indirect impact associated with operation of the Project?
2. Is the measure Chelan PUD responsibility?
3. Is the measure consistent with or a result of relicensing studies?
4. Is the measure consistent with the State Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation
5. Consistency with the planning document (SCORP) and other adopted planning documents (added from May 15 working group meeting)

**Further evaluation of PME's**

1. Is the measure an enhancement of an existing park or facility?
2. Is the location of the proposed measure on existing PUD lands or within the Rocky Reach Project reservoir and/or tributaries?
3. Costs: Is the request a reasonable expenditure?
4. Has the issue been previously addressed? Is there an easement for example.
5. Does the PUD have the legal authority to address the request?
6. Is the request feasible, workable; ie how would it be administered or implemented?
7. How would the request affect Project economics?
8. How would the request affect power rates throughout Chelan County?
9. What is the effectiveness of the measure(s) on the resource(s)?
10. Will the measure impact other resources and how?
11. Is there measurable stakeholder support (if applicable)?
12. Is there cost-sharing opportunity?
13. When would the measure be implemented?
