Today, March 28, 2017, Jon Cofrancesco (FERC) called me to obtain further clarification regarding information that was reported on the Recreation Facilities Table versus what is identified on the asbuilt, which we filed with FERC on October 21, 2016 (49481). Once we provide the additional information he is requesting, he will determine whether new as-builts are necessary.

Please provide clarification regarding the following facilities by end of day tomorrow, March 29, 2017.

- 1. Unable to identify 108 picnic tables. The shelters (2 @ 12 tables each) and campsite tables (31 RV sites and 26 tent sites) equal 81 tables. The remaining 27 tables are stored at an open lot at the north end of the park and moved around according to group needs, and some are dispersed on the drawing.
- 2. Where is the bench along the Entiatqua Trail? It is on the west side of highway 97Alt on the north side of the mouth of the Entiat River. It is near Item 9, Fish & Wildlife interpretive site. (lat/long 47.662231, -120.225027)
- 3. Unable to identify 77 day use parking spaces Not all of them are lined at this point, but there are 77. Unlined paved parking is in the area next to Items N and M, which is the north picnic shelter and bathroom. Also, day-use parking is available at the gravel area to the south of the boat launch and the triangle-shaped gravel area at the north entrance to the park.

4. Where is the 250-linear-foot swim beach? The undefined swim beach is at the north end of the park. (lat/long 47.671785, -120.211523)
