Dear Secretary Bose and Deputy Secretary Davis, Sr.:

On May 10, 2011, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued an “Order Granting Extension of Time” for the Lake Chelan Hydroelectric Project (Project). Ordering Paragraph (A) granted the Public Utility District No. 1 of Chelan County, Washington (Chelan PUD or Licensee) to file a Traditional Cultural Property (TCP) Management Plan by the extended deadline of November 1, 2011, to comply with Article 401 and Appendix A, Article 10(f) of the license.<sup>1</sup>

Chelan PUD hereby respectfully files the TCP Management Plan as Attachment A for Commission approval.

On July 21, 2011, Chelan PUD requested comments from the Lake Chelan Cultural Forum by August 26, 2011. Rob Whitlam of the Department of Archaeology and Historic Preservation, Bob Mierendorf of the National Park Service, Guy Moura of the Colville Confederated Tribes and Powys Gadd of the U.S.D.A. Forest Service provided comments (see Attachment B). Johnson Meninick of the Yakama Tribes, Anya Rardin of the Bureau of Land Management and Chuck James of the Bureau of Internal Affairs did not comment.
