#### Overview

- 105-day session ended on schedule
- 53 bills of interest passed the legislature
- Significant actions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions
- Environmental justice actions prominent in legislation
- Funding requests in the capital budget
- All bills of interest delivered to the governor for signature
- All bills are effective July 25 unless otherwise noted



## Top 2021 Legislative Priorities

#### Capital budget funding requests – HB 1080 (effective when signed)

- Signing May 18
- Dryden wastewater funding
  - \$1M capital budget request Local Community Project
  - \$2.49M grant program requests Centennial Clean Water Fund
- Rocky Reach water-filled turbine hub support
  - \$1M Clean Energy Fund
- Surface water feasibility study for second regional water source
  - \$300K capital budget request Local Community Project
- Support Peshastin Water District's \$1.1M request for a new well

#### Wildfire legislation

- HB 1168 Forest restoration, community resilience and wildfire response (\$125M/biennium General Fund)
  (Signed May 13)
- SB 5158 Wildland Fire Committee (Signed May 3)



## Energy/Electric Vehicles

- E2SSB 5126 Cap and Invest (Signing May 17)
- E3SHB 1091 Low carbon fuel standard (Signing May 17)
- 2SSB 5000 Hydrogen vehicles (Signed May 3)
- E2SHB 1287 Preparing for zero-emissions vehicle future (Signed May 13)
- 2SSB 5192 Electric vehicle equipment (Signed May 10)



### Telecom

- ESHB 1336 Retail telecom authority for PUDs (Signed May 13)
- 2SSB 5383 Retail telecom authority for unserved areas only (Signed May 13)
- Broadband funding \$411M total (in the capital budget)
  - \$326M for State Broadband office
  - \$60M for Public Works Board grants and loans
  - \$25M for Community Economic Revitalization Board (CERB)



## **Human Resources and Safety**

- E2SHB 1073 Paid family & medical leave (Signed April 21)
- ESSB 5097- Paid family & medical leave (Signed May 10)
- ESHB 1097 Worker protections (Signed May 11)
- ESSB 5115 Health emergency labor standards (Signed May 11)
- SHB 1323 Long-term care (Signed April 21)



#### Water

- HB 1143 Water rights banking pilot (Signed April 21)
- ESHB 1184 Reuse of gray water (Signed May 3)



### Other Bills of Interest

- SHB 1446 Bill to seek Energy Independence Act penalties relief for utilities (Signed April 16)
- ESHB 1368 \$325M in federal funding for rental and utilities (Signed Feb. 19)
- E2SSB 5141 HEAL act (environmental justice) (Signing May 17)
- SB 5032 Alternative public works contracting (Signed May 10 effective immediately)
- SB 5063 Invasive Species Council reauthorization (Signed May 3)
