A RESOLUTION RATIFYING FIELD WORK ORDERS NOS. 1-6 AND AUTHORIZING FINAL ACCEPTANCE OF WORK PERFORMED UNDER BID NO. 18-85 WITH DELTA STAR, INC. OF SAN CARLOS, CALIFORNIA

FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND REASONS FOR ACTION

Public Utility District No. 1 of Chelan County (District) adopted Resolution No. 19-14368 on August 5, 2019 which authorized the District to enter into a contract (Bid No. 18-85) with Delta Star, Inc. (Contractor) of San Carlos, California for Mobile Substation Replacement and Cable Trailers – Schedule A, in the amount of \$4,614,176.00.

The District Commission by Resolution No. 17-14215 delegated limited authority to the General Manager and the staff to execute field work orders under certain circumstances.

The work in Field Work Orders Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 consists of conditions and work not anticipated or included in the original contract but within the scope of the contract. The District's staff has executed Field Work Orders Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, which are on file in the offices of the District and summarized as follows:

Field Work Orders No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 result in a net increase in the contract price by \$9,650.00 for a new revised total price of \$4,623,826.00 (excluding sales tax), which the District's Engineers recommend be ratified. Resolution No 14-14215 provides that this type of field work order shall be presented to the Commission for approval as part of the final acceptance resolution.

District staff has determined that the completion of all contract work occurred on January 6, 2021.
