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A RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS AND DECLARING THAT NO BIDS WERE RECEIVED FOR THE SUPPLY OF STEEL STRUCTURES FOR NORTH SHORE SUBSTATION (BID NO. 22-12074) AND AUTHORIZING THE SUPPLY OF STEEL STRUCTURES FOR NORTH SHORE SUBSTATION BE OBTAINED BY NEGOTIATION

#### FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND REASONS FOR ACTION

The Commission, by Resolution No. 17-14215, delegated authority to the General Manager to advertise, award and execute contracts when the total contract price is \$3,000,000 or less.

District staff prepared bidding documents for the supply of Steel Structures for North Shore Substation. This bid was required to purchase the steel structures for North Shore Substation.

Sealed proposals were invited and published in accordance with RCW 54.04.070 and said bids were opened on June 15, 2022, at 2:00p.m. Pacific Time in the offices of the District.

Three bids were received pursuant to that invitation. All bid proposals exceeded the engineer's estimate by more than 15% and/or included material changes to the terms and conditions of the bid.

District staff is of the opinion that the bids were non-responsive and should be rejected. Resolution No. 17-14215 requires that the rejection of bids must come before the Commission for action when staff is recommending an action other than rebidding.

Pursuant to RCW 54.04.080, the District may procure the work on the open market and negotiate a contract rather than re-advertising if no bids are received. District staff recommends that, due to time constraints and project requirements, the Substation Circuit Switchers be procured by negotiation, rather than re-advertising for bids.

The General Manager of the District has reviewed District staff's recommendation and concurs in the same.
