A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT 1 OF SERVICES UNDER **INTERLOCAL** AGREEMENT (SA NO. 19-10436) WITH THE UNITED **STATES** DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, ANIMAL & PLANT HEALTH INSPECTION SERVICE (USDA APHIS), WILDLIFE SERVICES OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON TO PERFORM PREDATOR CONTROL AND **BIRD/ANIMAL** NUISANCE CONTROL (FOR NORTHERN PIKEMINNOW, FURBEARERS AND PISCIVOROUS BIRDS)

FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND REASONS FOR ACTION

Resolution No. 20-14459 dated June 1, 2020 ratified an Interlocal Agreement (SA No. 19-10436) with United States Department of Agriculture Animal & Plant Health Inspection Service, Wildlife Services (USDA APHIS) to perform predator control and nuisance bird/animal control for Northern Pikeminnow, furbearers and piscivorous birds, in an amount not to exceed \$488,283.00 through December 31, 2020.

USDA APHIS continues to perform this work to the satisfaction of the District and has the appropriate authority and permits to conduct the work. District staff has determined that USDA APHIS is the best qualified firm to continue to provide the required services and that the costs proposed for the services is a fair and reasonable price.

District staff recommends executing an amendment to Interlocal Agreement No. 19-10436 with USDA APHIS to continue predator control and nuisance bird/animal control for Northern Pikeminnow, furbearers and piscivorous birds for four (4) additional years through December 31, 2024 for an additional cost of \$2,141,146.00, increasing the not to exceed amount to \$2,629,429.00 through 2024.

The General Manager has reviewed District staff's recommendation and concurs in the same.

ACTION

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF CHELAN COUNTY, WASHINGTON as follows:

Section 1. The General Manager of the District is hereby authorized to execute Amendment 1 to Interlocal Agreement (SA No. 19-10436) with USDA APHIS to perform continued predator control and nuisance bird/animal control for

Northern Pikeminnow, furbearers and piscivorous birds in an amount not to exceed \$2,629,429.00 through December 31, 2024 without prior Commission approval. A copy of the Agreement is on file in the offices of the District.
