Why We Are Here

“The boundaries of the . . . commissioner districts . . . shall be **examined** every ten years”

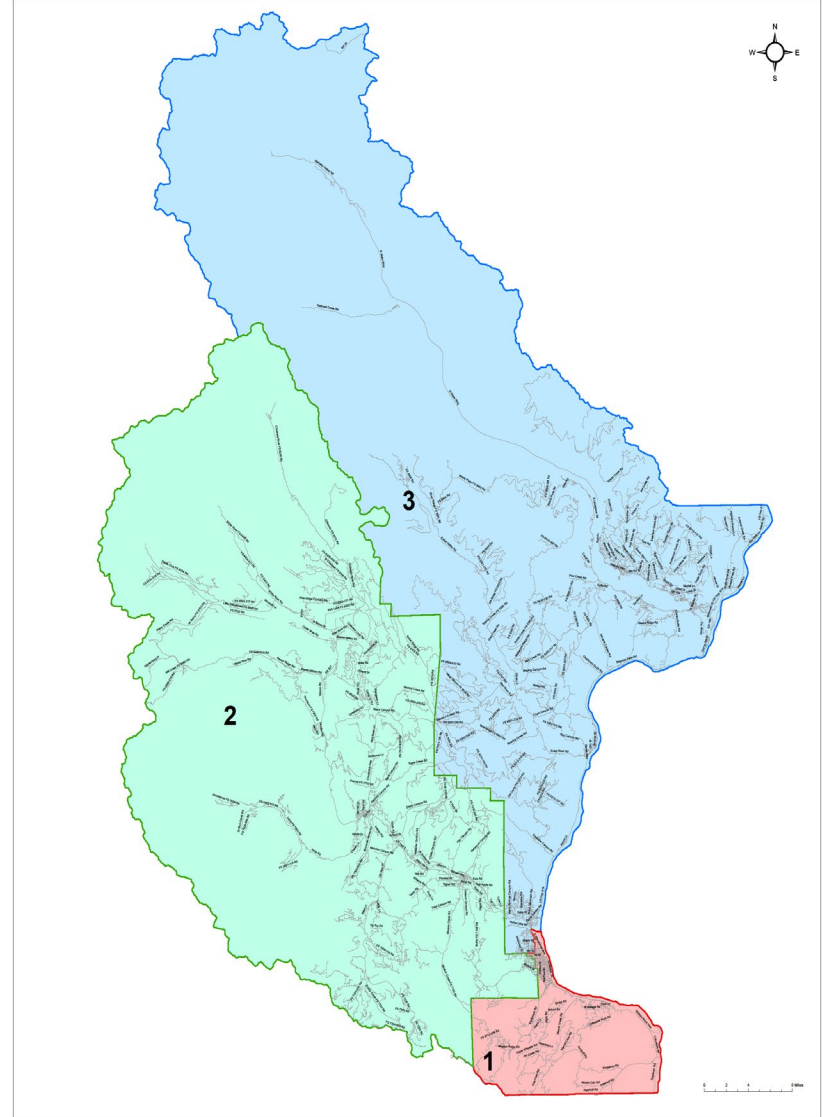
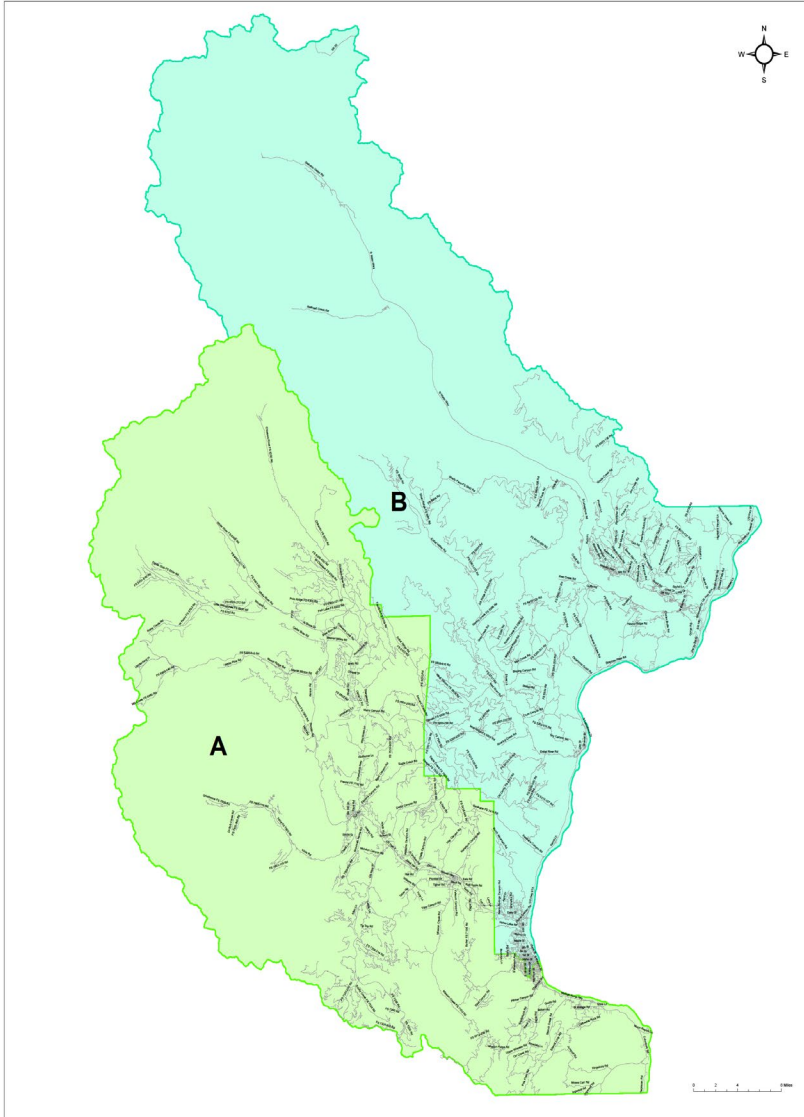
- Following the decennial census;
- Redistricting usually completed by November 15 of year following census;
- Deadline extended this year to December 31 because of pandemic related delays;
- No change to substantive criteria of redistricting.

Process

- Goal: Public Notice of Actions
- PUD Statute
 - Two-week notice of public hearing
 - Public hearing (December 30)
 - All commissioners present
- General Redistricting Statute (Updated in 2018)
 - Notice of public meeting and comment period
 - Public meeting within 10 days of notice and one week before adopting (meeting today)
 - Plan published on District's website
 - If necessary, any changes to plan published for one week before adoption
- District is complying with both statutes

Plan and Recommendation

- Coordination with Chelan County Auditor
 - Past redistricting efforts
 - District uses same maps as County for numbered districts
 - Auditor concluded that no changes to present maps are warranted
- Recommendation: adopt same boundaries for Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, and A and B



Next Steps

- Consider Public Comments
- Continue Publishing Notice of Hearing
- Public Hearing (December 30) – Adopt boundaries by resolution
