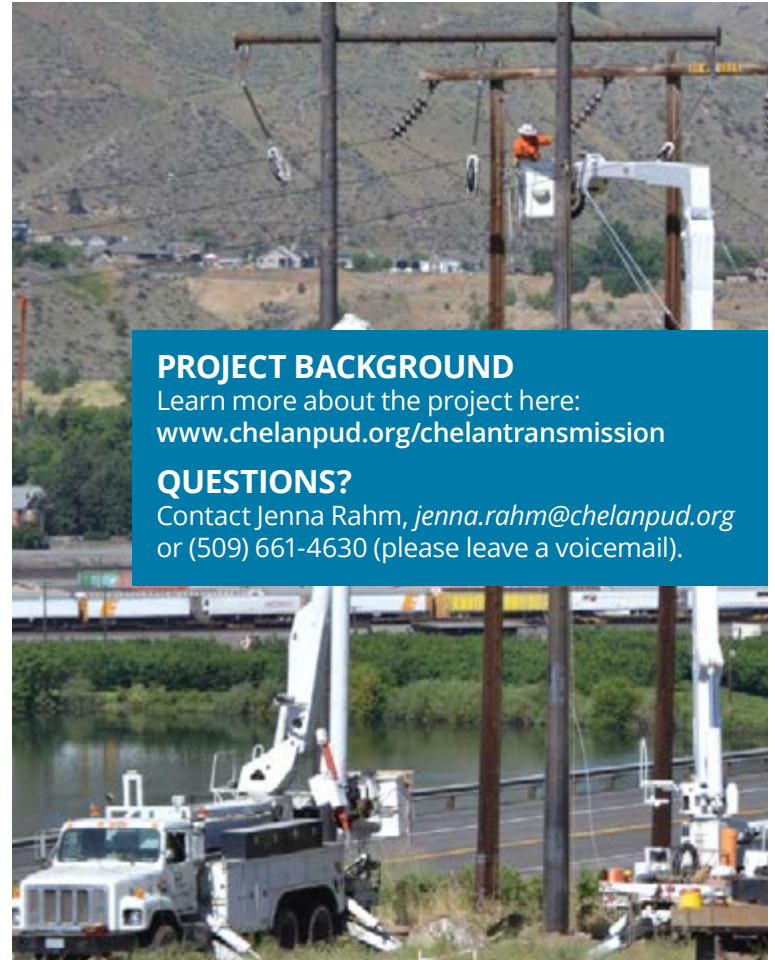


CONSTRUCTION STARTS THIS SUMMER!

Starting this summer, Chelan PUD will upgrade the transmission line that runs from Union Valley to Chelan Falls from wood to steel poles. The Chelan Transmission Fire Hardening Project is aimed at reducing the severity and duration of power outages during wildfires on the high-voltage transmission system serving the Lake Chelan Valley.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Work will begin in late June 2021 and continue into January 2022.
- Working hours are generally Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Crews will replace wood poles with steel poles between Union Valley and Chelan Falls.
- Poles will remain in the same general alignment as they are currently.
- To ensure clearances are compliant with regulatory requirements, some poles may be taller than existing structures, and some may be shorter.
- Crews may need to access poles on private property to complete this work.
