Proposed amendment

- Strengthens existing regulations to better protect the District's liability when service is interrupted
- Meets utility best practices
- Satisfies growing regulatory pressure
- Reduces risks when events occur that interrupt or discontinue service.



Examples of potential service interruptions

- Temporary service interruptions may be required when:
 - Mitigating risks from wildfires;
 - Loss of service due to cyberattacks;
 - Protecting performance or reliability;
 - Making repairs or improvements; or
 - Other causes (windstorms, earthquakes, etc.)
- Whenever practicable, reasonable advance public notice will be given.
