Call To Order

President Arseneault called the meeting to order at 10:03am

Pledge of Allegiance and Safety/HPI Minute

 Peter Vanney, Data Analyst II, led the pledge and provided information on COVID19 distancing and safe practices; we don't want to drift into complacency

Cycle of Personal Ownership (CPO) Winner Recognition

Steve Wright, General Manager, recognized the July winner Vince Norton, Journeyman Mechanic

Quarterly Energy Resources Update

(see Chelan PUD website for presentation)

- Gregg Carrington, Managing Director of Energy Resources, gave an update on the market over the weekend
 - California went into system emergency on Friday and Saturday with rolling blackouts
 - The Northwest was able to provide some energy through the intertie, but not as much as California had planned on, due to supply and demand
 - The Northwest had record heat this weekend and several utilities used the recently-developed resource adequacy program to help each other during peak demand
- Gregg Carrington and Janet Jaspers, Director of Energy Operations, Planning and Trading, reviewed the 2nd
 Quarter report

- The Mid-C flat market price for 2020 has dropped \$7.47/MWh from \$28.30/MWh at budget to the current forecast of \$20.83/MWh; our hedging program has price locked in for most of our portfolio so there is not much impact to 2020 net wholesale revenue
- o The Mid-C flat market prices for 2022-2025 have dropped between \$4.00 \$5.00/MWh
- Numerous Northwest utilities looking to purchase renewables and capacity products
- The District's 2020 net wholesale revenue forecast and other energy-related revenues is \$84.0 million, which is \$0.7 million below budget
- Steve Wright, General Manager, noted the applause he's received on the role Gregg Carrington has taken on with Resource Adequacy
- Steve also noted the pricing differences between this year and last year; anticipate this year is more like what we'll see going forward

Rocky Reach Facilities Update

- Casey Hall, Project Manager II, and Brett Bickford, Director of Engineering and Project Management, reviewed the current status of the Rocky Reach facilities project
- Bids opened last week for Rocky Reach facilities exceeded budget by \$1.9M
 - Steps are being taken to meet budget, including moving the office building on top of the crew building as a third floor and rebidding 3 packages that were significantly over budget
- Discovery Center bid packages were over budget by about \$365k; steps are being taken to meet budget
- Commissioners indicated a willingness to consider budget revisions for costs related to COVID19; those were unanticipated and would have impacted existing facilities if we had not been in the process of building new facilities
 - These are 50-year facilities; with the best for the most for the longest in mind, we want to build them to the level of quality that will last

Fiber Acceleration Update

- Bob Shane, Interim Managing Director of Fiber and Telecom, provided further information on the fiber acceleration project
- In the current forecast, most expansion is already included in 2021-2024; the acceleration project pulls forward additional premises currently scheduled in 2025 and 2026
- All expansion will be completed by the end of 2024; the additional \$2M is to complete those expanded premises by 2024
