Reason for Project

- Three long-term FERC licenses
 - Desire to be able to continue to meet current and future license obligations
- To fulfill District Mission and Vision
 - Adapt to climate change which may include more climate variability that affects our junior water rights
 - Retain flexibility for future opportunities



Chelan PUD Project Objectives

Protecting District assets to enhance the quality of life for Chelan County

Protect the District's municipal supplies, Parks, and our ability to meet FERC recreation obligations.

Protect the District's ability to operate reliably; and meet all FERC and NERC obligations.



Oroville-Tonasket Irrigation District (OTID) Water Bank

- OTID created a water bank in 2019 through the State's Trust Water Right Program
- The source of the water is Lake Osoyoos, the Similkameen River and the Okanogan River
- Ecology approved the use of that water for multiple downstream purposes including instream flow
- Through a long-term partnership with OTID, Chelan PUD would like to acquire access to 4,000 acre-feet of water on an annual basis

Benefit to our Customer Owners

- District will gain a significant asset to meet future water supply needs for hatcheries, parks, water systems, and power generation
- District negotiated a lease based on fair market price
- In the near-term, water will be used to maintain instream flows until water is needed
 - Similkameen, Okanogan, Columbia Rivers
- In the long-term, staff are evaluating opportunities for partnerships

Water Supply Agreement Elements

- Quantity: 4,000 acre-feet
- Annual Payment: \$1.0M base, with increases tied to CPI beginning at Year 10
- Duration: Indefinite with termination rights as set forth in the agreement
