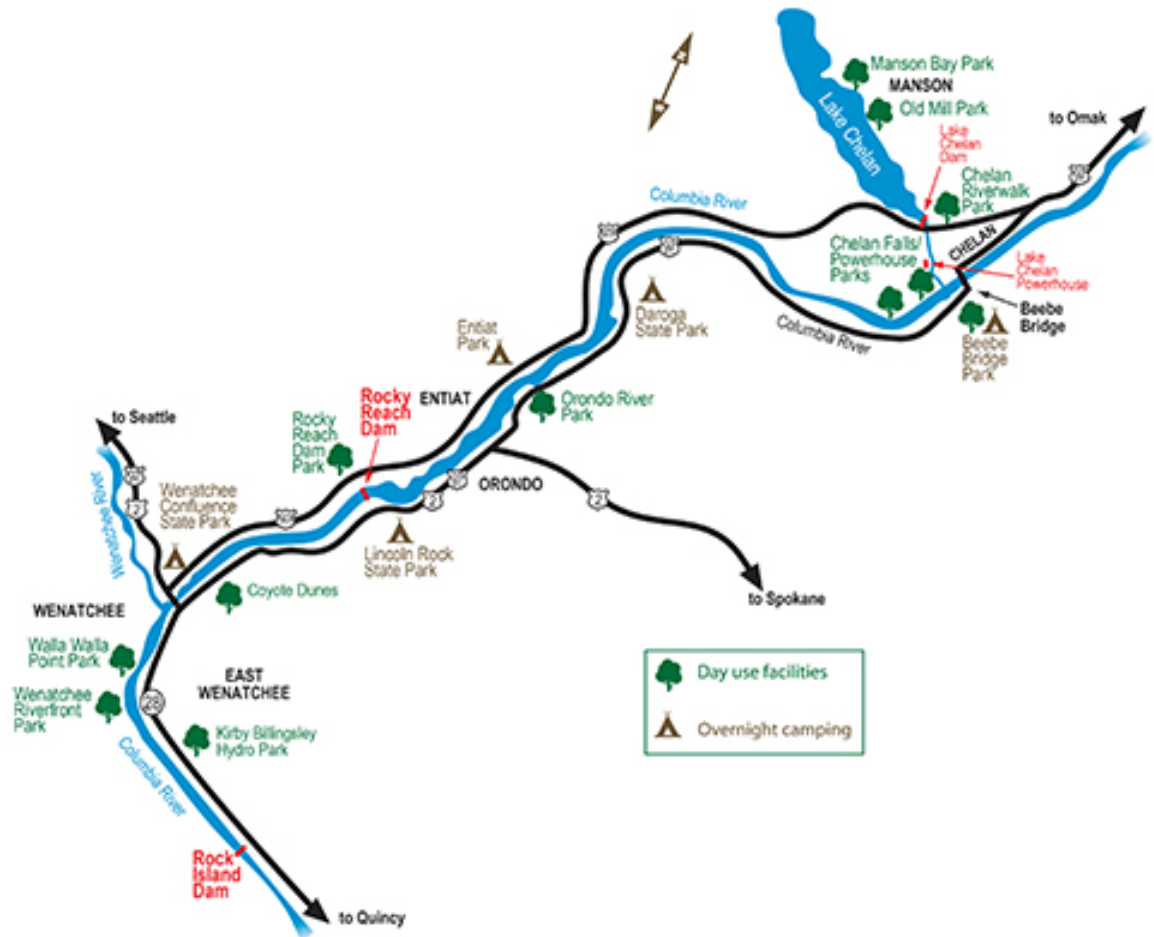

Chelan PUD Parks By the Numbers

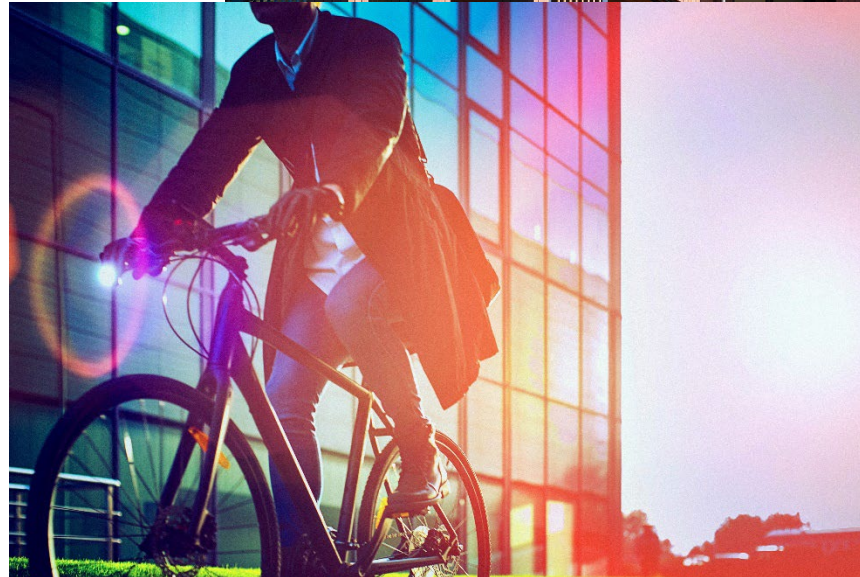
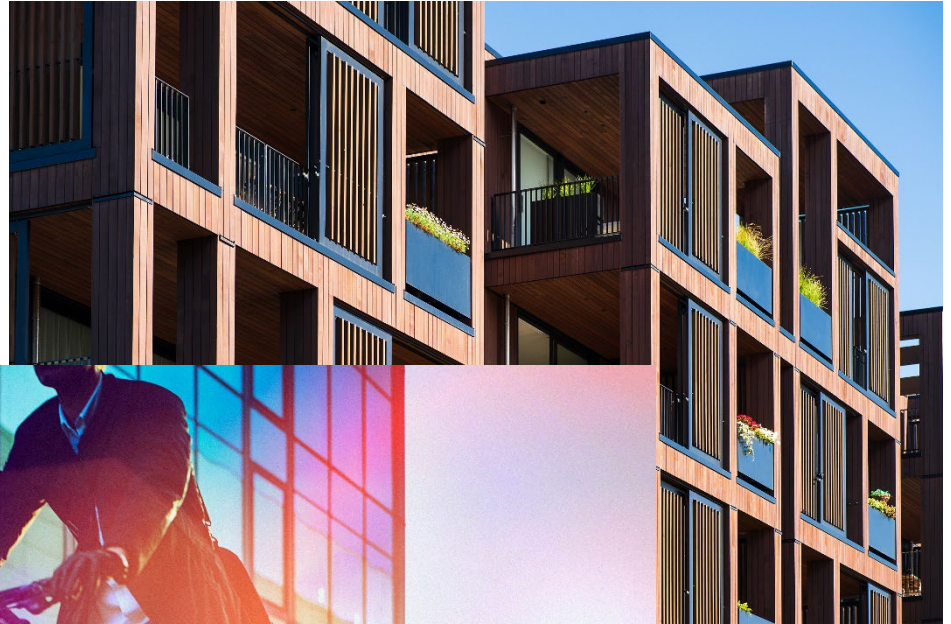
- 16 Parks
- 800 acres
- 17 miles of trails
- 324 camp sites in 5 campgrounds
- 12 boat launches
- 12 sports fields
- 3.5M visitors per year





PARK CHANGES

- Increase use due to hotels, apartments, and business and public interest
- 2023 trail awareness campaign
- Proactive engagement for trail etiquette around use trends for scooters, one wheels, e-bikes.
- Parking coordination with neighbors, business, and community
