Why We're Here


We are here to update progress on the Public Power Benefit Program through 2023.

- We added over 6,400 premises, including some remote areas of the county since 2016
- We have a PPB take-rate of 45%
- County coverage 81%




Premises Passed and Forecast



^{*}Amounts in red represent cumulative amounts




County Coverage and Forecast











