Why Are We Here?

- Present option to structure program funding to meet goal of accelerating Fiber
- Evaluate future PPB program impacts of funding Fiber Acceleration
- Consider supporting COVID-19 community response
- No Board action requested today but looking for direction on funding



Option to fund Fiber acceleration

Allocate project funding over multiple funding years:

- ➤ Allows acceleration of Fiber program
 - (\$4.3M original +\$2M added cost to accelerate = \$6.3M total for accelerated projects)
- ➤ Preserves availability of program funding for new projects or studies that may come forward prior to 2022
- > Utilizes funds from 2020 and 2021 to cover costs of acceleration buildout
- > Utilizes funds from 2022 for acceleration connections
- > More closely coincides funding with contractual commitments
- > Modification from the standard process of funding full project upfront is reasonable for the unique acceleration guidance

Summary of Funding Option

- Funding Fiber acceleration buildout can be done with current open PPB funding years (2020 and 2021)
 - Accelerated connections can be funded in 2022
- Preserves funding for quick-hit projects or studies
 - Unknown: Extent of project requests to support community response to COVID
 - Funding will remain available for smaller project and study requests through 2021 funding period
