Project Update Wenatchee Riverfront Park – Phase 1





Background and Bid Update

- The Riverfront Park Master Plan was completed in 2021 after significant public outreach and includes three phases
- Riverfront Park Enhancement Phase 1
 - Resolution authorizing bid approved by Board November 6, 2023
 - Parks Update to Board on March 18: Engineer's Estimate \$9.0M (includes additional work at Walla Walla Point Park)
 - Bid opening on March 28 (2 bidders)
 - Low Bid: \$9.67M (KRCI of East Wenatchee)
 - Riverfront Park elements: ~\$8.87M



Riverfront Park Project Funding

- Current project budget is \$7M with \$6M remaining
 - \$3.5M PPB
 - \$2M City of Wenatchee
 - \$1.4M Capital Reserves
- To proceed with the project, a budget revision is necessary to account for:
 - Unbudgeted project expenses based on actual construction costs
 - Contingency Funds (5% proposed)
 - Washington State Sales Tax (\$780K)
 - Design and Construction Management



Riverfront Park Project Expense Table

Washington State Sales Tax	\$780K	\$9.65M (contract amount)
Construction Contingency (5%)	\$443K	\$10.1M
Construction Management, Design	\$605K	\$10.7M
Deduct Budgeted Funds Remaining		\$6.0M (\$7M budget - \$1M expenditures to date)
Additional Funds To Proceed		\$4.7M



Board Options

- Defer action until May 6 Board Meeting
- Approve a budget revision to add funds, staff to proceed with bid award (can occur April 15 or May 6)
 - Staff will explore value engineering opportunities with contractor and pursue potential cost savings
- Pause project (reject bids); option to reconsider in the future
- Modify design, adjust scope to lower costs (reject bids, rebid in future)
