Sign up for Alerts and Warnings

As of April 1, 2024, Chelan County Emergency Management is using the **Everbridge Emergency Alert System** to notify citizens of emergency situations and potential safety hazards in the nearby area.

Anyone can register for Everbridge, whether you live, work or have family in Chelan County, the service is available to you.



Everbridge Emergency Alerts

- Create an account with Everbridge Emergency Alert Program:
<https://member.everbridge.net/406411280384261/login>
- Provide addresses where you would like to receive nearby alerts (home, work, school, etc.) and your preferred methods of contact. You will receive alerts based on the locations set up in your Everbridge account.
- Download the Everbridge mobile app directly to your cell phone and login to your account
- Enabling location-based alerts in the app settings will allow you to automatically receive nearby public safety notifications without having to subscribe to them

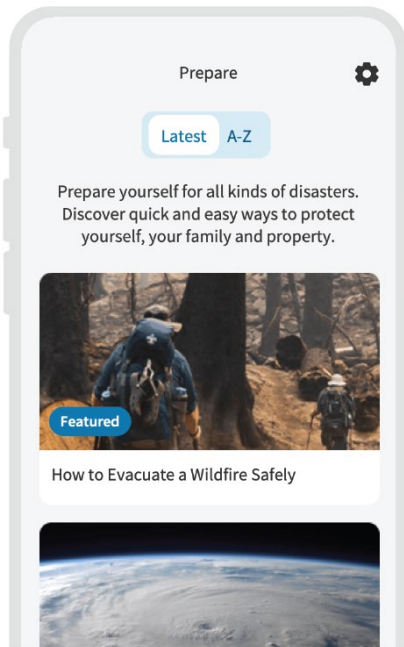
FEMA App

- ✓ Find out if your location is eligible for FEMA assistance, find Disaster Recovery Center locations, and get answers to your most pressing questions

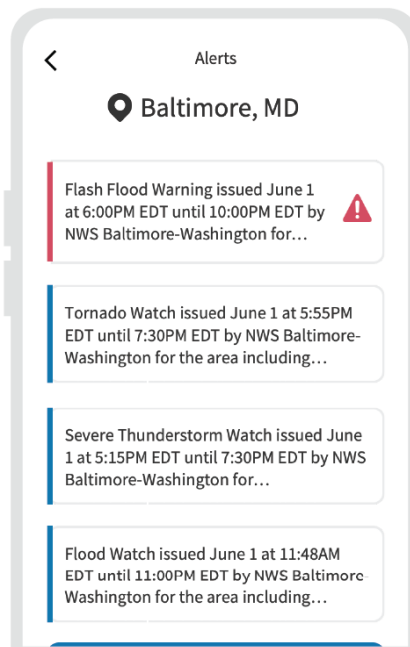

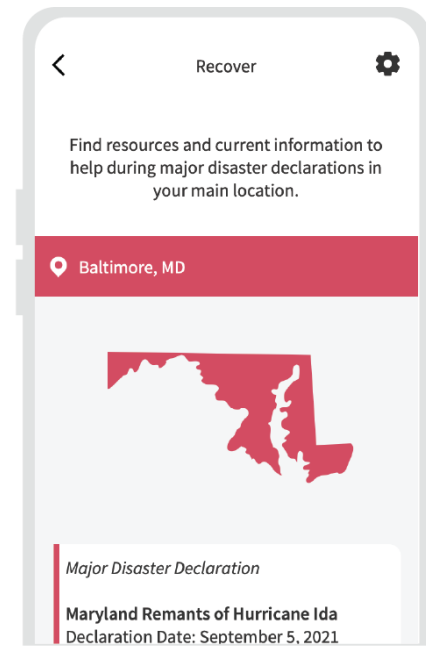

Chelan County Volunteer Opportunities	Description
Chelan County Emergency Worker Registration	A volunteer position. Emergency Workers may assist with specific tasks as assigned by Chelan County Emergency Management.
Chelan County Volunteer Search and Rescue (CCVSAR)	A volunteer responder organization affiliated with the Chelan County Sheriff's Office. Each year CCVSAR responds to dozens of missing and injured person calls in the backcountry wilderness and recreational areas of central Washington.
Chelan County Mountain Rescue (CCMR)	An all-volunteer organization whose purpose is to rescue ill or injured backcountry travelers from Chelan County's beautiful central Cascade Mountains.
American Red Cross Northwest Region	Volunteers serve in a variety of roles to help communities respond to and recover from disasters.
