Teen Driving Risks: Experience vs Distraction



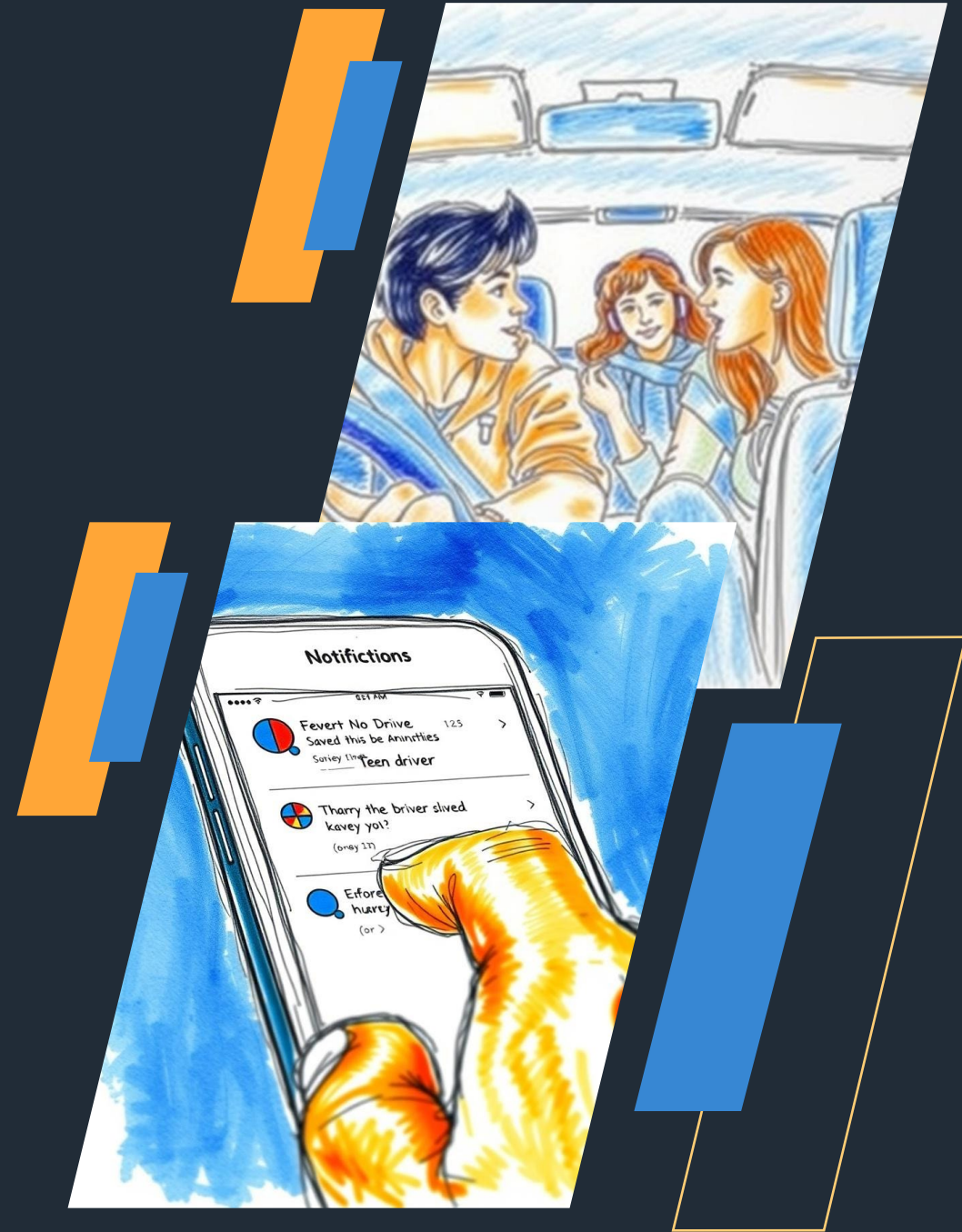
Experience Matters
