which means...

- More animals
- More driving
- More distractions

REDUCED VISIBILITY

due to...

- Glaring sun
- No sun
- ❖ Increased plant growth

VEHICLE CONDITION

such as...

- ❖ Insufficient tire tread
- ❖ Worn brake pads and rotors



RISK FACTORS



WARMER WEATHER

- * Awareness of animal patterns
- Conscious effort to prioritize driving safely while behind the wheel

REDUCED VISIBILITY

- * Readily available sunglasses
- Turn on fog lights/brights at night when appropriate
- Keep greenery near roads trimmed
- * Take your time

VEHICLE CONDITION

* Ensure tread depth is greater than 1/16 of an inch:



Replace brake pads every 25k-60k miles and rotors every 70k miles or less
