WARMER WEATHER

which means...

- ❖ More animals
- ❖ More driving
- ❖ More distractions



REDUCED VISIBILITY

due to...

- ❖ Glaring sun
- ❖ No sun
- ❖ Increased plant growth



VEHICLE CONDITION

such as...

- ❖ Insufficient tire tread
- ❖ Worn brake pads and rotors



RISK FACTORS



WARMER WEATHER

- ❖ Awareness of animal patterns
- ❖ Conscious effort to prioritize driving safely while behind the wheel

REDUCED VISIBILITY

- ❖ Readily available sunglasses
- ❖ Turn on fog lights/brights at night when appropriate
- ❖ Keep greenery near roads trimmed
- ❖ Take your time

VEHICLE CONDITION

- ❖ Ensure tread depth is greater than 1/16 of an inch:



- ❖ Replace brake pads every 25k-60k miles and rotors every 70k miles or less



RISK MITIGATION



BEAR IN MIND

- ❖ Your own safety and the safety of other drivers
- ❖ You can do everything right and still find yourself in an unpreventable situation. Call 911 if you hit a large animal that needs removal from the roadway
