# Water System Plan Update

- Chapter 246-290 WAC requires planning update every six years for systems with > 1,000 connections (Wenatchee system only)
- Final draft to Department of Health
- Final approval pending documentation
- Aligned with PUD 5-year business plan



# Water Use Efficiency Update

- The 2003 Municipal Water Law requires municipal water suppliers develop and implement plans to use water efficiently
- Updates submitted every six years
- The District has updated plans for the Wenatchee, Dryden, Ollala Canyon, Chelan Ridge and Chelan Falls systems



#### **Approval Process**

- Provide public notice
  - Water System Plan informational meeting
  - Adoption of Water Use Efficiency goal
  - Documentation available for public review
  - Invite public comment
- Hold informational public meeting
  - Public comments
  - Adopt Water Use Efficiency goal
- Forward meeting documentation and approved meeting minutes to Department of Health
- Await Department of Health approval
- Adopt Water System Plan
