

RESOLUTION NO. 12-13708

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A RATE INCREASE OF SIX PERCENT (6%) FOR WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICES

**FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND REASONS FOR ACTION**

Public Utility District No. 1 of Chelan County (“the District”), in compliance with RCW 54.24.080, is required to establish, maintain, and collect rates or charges for electric energy and water and other services, facilities, and commodities sold, furnished, or supplied by the District. The rates and charges shall be fair, nondiscriminatory, and shall be adequate to provide revenues sufficient for the payment of the principal of and interest on such revenue obligations for which the payment has not otherwise been provided and all payments which the District is obligated to set aside in any special fund or funds created for such purpose, and for the proper operation and maintenance of the public utility and all necessary repairs, replacements, and renewals thereof.

The District Commission on Sept. 27, 2010 authorized implementation of an updated Strategic Plan. The plan, titled “Anticipate and Respond: Strategies for a Sustainable Chelan County PUD,” is designed to align with customers’ expectations and desires as voiced in opinion surveys, public meetings, focus groups and e-mails. The Strategic Plan identifies four principal objectives that will guide operations: ensure lasting financial stability by developing and implementing a comprehensive, sustainable business model; establish and enhance lasting customer, employee and stakeholder relationships; provide valued public utility services by responsibly managing services; and operate responsibly.

District rate-setting guiding principles and customer input recommend movement toward closing the gap in the water and wastewater systems between revenues and operating costs; smaller incremental rate increases over time; supporting long-term rate stability; aligning the cost of service; and continued movement toward a “postage stamp” approach in which customers of all water systems are charged the same or similar rates for services.

A six percent (6%) increase for water and wastewater rates was included in the 2012 budget as part of the District’s efforts to close gaps between revenues and expenses. The proposed increase was discussed with District Commissioners during the Board meeting held January 16, 2012 in Wenatchee. The District Commissioners directed staff to initiate the public process for the proposed rate increases. Public notices were provided and meetings were held Feb. 6, 2012 in Wenatchee and Feb. 8, 2012 in Leavenworth. A public hearing was advertised to occur on March 5, 2012 in Wenatchee.

Staff recommends a six percent (6%) rate increase be adopted to increase overall water and wastewater revenue, consistent with the approved 2012 District budget, with an additional step increase applied to the Dryden water quantity rates to bring that system closer in line with cost of service and with other District systems. A six percent (6%) increase to the existing low-income assistance discounts is included in the rates. The General Manager concurs with staff.

The proposed rates are attached as Exhibit A as "2012 Water and Wastewater Rate Schedules." New rates, if adopted, would be effective April 1, 2012.

**ACTION**

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO.1 OF CHELAN COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:


Section 1. The Commission held public informational meetings and a public hearing regarding the described proposed rate increase for the District's water and wastewater systems. The Commission considered staff recommendations and public input.

Section 2. The water and wastewater rates set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto are determined to be fair, reasonable, necessary and non-discriminatory. The rates set forth in Exhibit A as "2012 Water and Wastewater Rate Schedules" shall be effective April 1, 2012.

Section 3. The adoption of this rate resolution is not a major action under the State Environmental Policy Act, and as such is categorically exempt under S.E.P.A. guidelines, W.A.C., Ch 197-1 1 -800(15)(i).





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# **RATE DISCOUNT FOR RESIDENTIAL WATER SERVICE**

A rate discount not to exceed \$8.00\* per month is available to all qualifying low-income seniors 62 years and older and low-income disabled as provided for in State of Washington R.C.W. 74.38.070. The rate discount will not exceed the amount of the monthly bill up to \$8.00\* per month and will be applied to one residential water account only.

## **QUALIFYING CRITERIA FOR LOW-INCOME SENIORS**

1. Age 62 years or older prior to or during the month in which the discount is to apply.
2. Total household income including his or her spouse or co-tenant does not exceed the amount specified in R.C.W. 84.36.381 (5) (b).
3. Ownership or occupancy as head of household residing therein at certain property being served water within the District's service area.

## **LOW-INCOME DISABLED**

1. Physical disability prior to application.
2. Special parking privileges as defined in State of Washington R.C.W 46.16.381(1) (a) through (f) or a blind person as defined in R.C.W 74.18.020.
3. Household income does not exceed 125% of Federal Poverty Income Guidelines.
4. Ownership or occupancy as head of household residing therein at certain property being served water within the District's service area.

\* Rate discount for Chelan Falls residential water service is \$7.26. See Chelan Falls Water System.
