Doesn't want a smart meter. Concerned about her community and the fact that her neighbors may have the meter and they are close to her house.

She has a cell tower near her house and it emits 2 volts of energy that is detected in her yard.

Why can't these meters just collect a signal when they need to read for billing purposes; and why can't they send an outage message only when there is an outage or other alert.

She talked to a scientist at the FCC in D.C. who told her it's not just the duration of the pulse from the meter, but also the intensity/voltage strength and that these meters emit energy that can disrupt DNA – we probably won't know in our lifetime the destruction that all of the energy pulses are doing to us – not just the meters, but appliances, cell phones, wi-fi, etc.
