Meeting Purpose: Meeting of the Rocky Reach Wildlife Forum to continue Rocky Reach license implementation

## **Minutes**

Von Pope welcomed everyone to the Rocky Reach Wildlife (RRWF) meeting and made known that voice recording of the meeting was initiated for note-taking purposes only.

In 2013, consistent with the RRWF proposal, Chelan PUD distributed 12,100 biological control insects to control diffuse knapweed on public lands between the Entiat River and Knapp Coulee within the Rocky Reach Wildlife Area (RRWA). Von Pope noted that due to the government shut down, the 1 October 2013 meeting was canceled, so the RRWF was unable approve payment for work conducted in 2013 via subcontractor through Chelan PUD as sheduled. Therefore, Von e-mailed the RRWF asking for reimbursement approval prior to this October 31, 2013 meeting. E-mail approval was received from the following members (see attached).

While the December 11, 21012 meeting minutes were approved via e-mail in late December of 2012, Von highlighted some of the main points from that meeting. Von shared with the RRWF that the current Rocky Reach Wildlife Habitat Management Plan (RRWHMP) expires September 22, 2015. It was noted that the 2013 RRWHMP does not allow flexibility or contingencies in the event of flood, wildfire, or other unforeseen circumstances. Therefore, the RRWF needs to consider different options to provide potential future flexibility for natural disasters in the 2015 RRWHMP. Von suggested that agencies draft types of projects but not to be too specific as to where implementation of the projects would occur, as this might be a way to build flexibility into the RRWHMP. After further discussion, the RRWF agreed that once the 2015 RRWHMP is drafted, Jeff and Von will contact the FERC to ask for guidance as to the best way to build flexibility into the plan.

## Biological Weed Control Presentation:

To help understand the biological weed controls and the projects completed in 2012 and 2013, Dale Whaley from the Washington State University, Douglas County Extension presented "Chelan County PUD Rocky Reach Wildlife Area Biological Weed Control Project 2012-13" PowerPoint to the RRWF. Dale summarized that biological weed control is the intentional use of living organisms to reduce invasive plant density. Bio-controls limit the target plants ability to spread by use of insects that are ecologically desirable with no non-target effects. Biological control insects go through rigorous testing for host specificity prior to being approved for release. Also, the insects are mobile, providing a long-term solution in hard-to-access areas such as the RRWA, and they are cost effective. However, it does take time for the population of the bio-controls to catch up to host species density, so effects are not noticed immediately. In some cases, it can take 4 years or more for biological controls to have a visible effect. Since the post –fire areas around Burch Mountain and Swakane Canyon have a high density of weeds, particularly Dalmatian toadflax. Dale suggested that additional releases in the area treatedin 2012 would be beneficial. Dale also thought that seeding the biological weed control areas with native seed mix in 4-5 years would be a good idea to assist the treated areas in outcompeting undesirable vegetation.

# Review 2014 Integrated Noxious Weed Plan:

After viewing Dale Whaley's presentation, the RRWF agreed that additional biological weed control should be implemented in the 2014 Integrated Terrestrial Invasive Plant Control Plan Project Proposal. Von noted that there is roughly \$11,000 available for 2014 projects. Brigitte Ranne of the USFS suggested reseeding should be included in future years for the treated biological weed control areas as recommended by Dale Whaley.

#### **Action Items:**

- Von and Jeff will contact FERC and ask their recommendation as to how to build natural disaster response into the 2015 RRWHMP.
- Von will draft an email for approval regarding entering into a contract with Dale Whaley from the WSU Extension for the biological weed control project in 2014.
- 4 November 2013: Von will email a draft 2014 Integrated Terrestrial Invasive Plant Control Plan Project Proposal for review/comments to the RRWF for their review/comments.
- 18 November 2013 RRWF will provide their comments to Von
- Von will talk to Dave Volson regarding his submittal of detail mapping proposal for the 2014 RRWHMP.
